



## A Strong Performing, Low Risk, Small-Cap Solution

### Three Compelling Reasons to Consider the Value Line Small Cap Opportunities Fund:

#### 1. Historically Lower Overall Volatility 2. Impressive Risk-Adjusted Results 3. Outperformance

Among small growth funds, performance is only part of the story. Assessing the level of risk to achieve that performance is key. The Value Line Small Cap Opportunities Fund seeks smaller growth companies with a demonstrated history of consistently growing their earnings and stock price over 10+ years or longer.

### 1. Historically Lower Overall Volatility

Compared to the Morningstar Small Growth Category, the Fund has provided lower overall volatility based on historical standard deviation for the 3, 5 and 10 year periods ended June 30, 2024.

### 2. Impressive Risk-Adjusted Results

The Fund's Sharpe Ratio ranked in the top 3% for the 3 and 10-year periods, and the top 10% or better for the 5-year period, among 547 funds in the Morningstar Small Growth category. Sharpe Ratio measures the risk-adjusted return of an asset, i.e., the amount of return has been received for the level of risk assumed.

### 3. Outperformance

The Fund outperformed both the Morningstar Small Growth Category average and the Russell 2000 Index for the 1, 3, 5 and 10-year periods as of June 30, 2024. The Fund is the only fund in the Morningstar Small Growth Category (among 163 unique funds) that has a “Low” Risk Rating for the 3, 5 and 10-year periods, and top 20% performance or better for the 3, 5 and 10-year periods, as of June 30, 2024.

The Morningstar Rating™ for funds, or “star rating” is calculated for managed products (including mutual funds, variable annuity and variable life subaccounts, exchange-traded funds, closed-end funds, and separate accounts) with at least a three-year history. Exchange-traded funds and open-ended mutual funds are considered a single population for comparative purposes. It is calculated based on a Morningstar Risk-Adjusted Return measure that accounts for variation in a managed product’s monthly excess performance, placing more emphasis on downward variations and rewarding consistent performance. The top 10% of products in each product category receive 5 stars, the next 22.5% receive 4 stars, the next 35% receive 3 stars, the next 22.5% receive 2 stars, and the bottom 10% receive 1 star. The Overall Morningstar Rating for a managed product is derived from a weighted average of the performance figures associated with its three-, five-, and 10-year (if applicable) Morningstar Rating metrics. The weights are: 100% three-year rating for 36-59 months of total returns, 60% five-year rating/40% three-year rating for 60-119 months of total returns, and 50% 10-year rating/30% five-year rating/20% three-year rating for 120 or more months of total returns. While the 10-year overall star rating formula seems to give the most weight to the 10-year period, the most recent three-year period actually has the greatest impact because it is included in all three rating periods.
